

Prof. Edward Ng's speech receiving the GBA Grand Award:

In 2006, 11 students died of CO poisoning burning coal in their classroom for warmth. I think our eco-school has provided a solution. No more.

After the 512 and 830 earthquakes, WZQ went to the area. I saw a little tent. The old lady inside told me, "I have lost everything, I will live here for the remain of my life". What would you do? ... We built her a new home before the next Chinese New Year set in. Not only that, with the support of MoHURD and Lee Hysan Foundation, we re-built all the houses in the fallen village.

I believe green buildings are there to improve life, and sometimes to save life. Otherwise and beyond that, chasing credits is like chasing phantom, it would be meaningless.
